Your Opportunities to Support Recycling and Composting

During your visit, help us reduce the waste footprint by recycling and composting your waste! Please review the list below and let staff know if you have questions:

- ❖ **Re-Usable Cups:** *When you arrive you will be given a re-usable insulated stainless-steel cup to use for hot and cold beverages. Please write your name on it and keep track of it during your visit. This cup is yours to keep.*
- ❖ **Compost Food Waste:** *Food waste has a big impact on the environment. In a landfill, it can create volatile greenhouse gasses but when properly composted, it can feed soil microbes, grow healthy soil and help sequester carbon. During your visit, please place all of your uneaten food in the correct bins so it can be part of the solution and not the problem.*
- ❖ **Recycle:** *You will find trash and recycle bins throughout the ranch. Please pay close attention to staff directions or posted signs that show you what types of waste to recycle or compost and where.*
